NOTE: The candidate must apply **Online only**. No other mode of application shall be accepted.

1. The successful candidate will be required to submit legible Self attested copies of the documents. Admit Card along with the hard copy of print out of online application form at the time of verification of documents *(any information contained in the attached certificates shall not be considered unless it is claimed in the application form)*.
2. The candidate must carry Aadhaar Card/Voter ID Card/Driving License/Pan Card/ any government authorized Identity Proof in original along with the admit card to the examination centre, failing which they shall not be allowed to appear for the examination.

1. EXAMINATION FEES AND MODE OF PAYMENT:

- i. ₹ 100 FOR APST candidates and ₹ 150 for other (*to be paid online only*).
- ii. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- I. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- II. The educational qualification, age, experience, etc as stipulated in the advertisement shall be determined as on the closing date of submission of application.

3. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

- The candidates will have to appear in written examination/test to be conducted by the board. It will be consisting of 02(two) Stages for Post Code 1/18, 2/18, 3/18:-

Stage 1(Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions) 300 Marks:

The test will comprise of the following subjects:

- (a) General English – 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus:- In addition to testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English Language, questions on its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc would also be covered.

- (b) Elementary Math - 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus:- The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover number systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Data Interpretations, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit and Loss, Discount, Simple and Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time And Work, Time and Distance, Tables and Graphs etc.

- (c) General Knowledge – 100 marks (50 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus: - Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidates General Knowledge of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The Test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art and Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations/Institutions etc. State specific questions may also be asked.

- The test will be of Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions comprising of 150 questions as mentioned above. Each question will carry 02(two) marks. The candidate will have to complete the test in 03(three) hours. There will be a negative marking of 1/4 for incorrect answer (i.e. 1/4 of 2 = 0.5 marks).
- A candidate must secure a minimum of 33% or more marks in each subject in the written examination paper and must secure 45% of marks out of aggregate total marks in the written examination paper. In other words selection in **first stage** will be based on the aggregate total marks secured in the written examination paper. The candidate securing less than 33% of marks in any of the subject shall be deemed not eligible for selection.
- The total number of candidates selected in **first stage** will be in 1:3 ratio. For e.g. if total numbers of seats are 10, then 30 candidates will be selected for Stage 2.

Stage 2 (Trade Test) 50 Marks

- Only the successful candidates from Stage 1, as per the above prescribed ratio, will be allowed to appear for Trade Test which will be of 50 marks.
- *The details of the trade test will be intimated later on the official website.*

Final Merit will be based on total marks obtained in Stage 1 and Stage 2 i.e. out of 350 marks (300 + 50).

4. HOW TO APPLY: Candidate are required to apply online through the official website www.apssb.in.

5. Scanned copies of following documents and information are to be attached/uploaded.

- Scanned signature of the candidate on white paper with black ink pen (20-60 kb in jpeg format)
- Latest/recent passport size photo (40-100 kb in jpg format).
- LTI (Left Thumb Impression) & RTI (right Thumb Impression) (20-60 kb in jpg format)

6. The final recommended candidate will have to submit copies of the following documents/information to the Board.

- Recent passport size passport.
- Matriculation certificates issued by the Board/University for proof of date of birth.
- Class XII Certificate with Mark sheet.
- Degree certificate with Mark sheet issued by the Assistant Register/Registered/Controller of Examination/Vice Chancellor of the concerned University to ascertain educational qualification.
- Post Graduate certificate (if any).
- APST Certificate and PRC.
- Any other document as may be relevant.
- Intimation letter to HoD for those who are in regular Govt. Service.

Qualified candidates will have to produce the above mentioned Certificates/Documents and mark sheet in original otherwise his/her application will be rejected.

NOTE:-

- I. There is no provision of re-evaluation /re-checking of Answer Sheet /Answer Scripts in respect of the examinations conducted by APSSB.
- II. The APSSB reserves the right to cancel/withdraw any question/questions from the Test.
- III. The Board makes provisional selection of the candidate on the basis of information provided in the application and document/certificates provided by the candidate at the time of submission of document and recommend the same to the indenting/ user department. Further the Appointing Authority i.e. the indenting/user department verifies and satisfies itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates and eligibility as per the Recruitment Rules before finally appointing the candidate(s). Therefore, the provisional selection of a candidate does not confirm upon him/her any right of appointment unless the Appointing Authority is satisfied, after such inquiry as may be considered necessary, that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the post.
- IV. In case of combined examination for more than one related posts the preference order of the posts by the candidate will be obtained at the time of document verification.
- V. If there are two or more candidates in the same category having equal marks in the examination, the candidate older in age will get preference. In case of further tie, candidate having higher marks in class XII for post code 1/18 and post code 2/18 and class X for post code 3/18 shall be preferred.
- VI. Candidates may apply for more than one post code but the Board may hold the examinations of two or more different post code on the same day and candidate may opt to take the examination of any one post code only.

7. AGE:

- i. The candidate must not be less than 18 years and above 32 years of age as on **19/01/2019**. However, the upper age limit is relaxable in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in respect of various categories as indicated below:

APST	Relaxable upto 05 (five) years.
ExSM	Service rendered in army/navy/air force plus 03 (three) years subject to a maximum age limit of 50 (fifty) years.

8. GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR CANDIDATES

- i. The vacancies published are provisional and liable to vary. In case the vacancy position is reduced to any number or even withdrawn by the user department, the Board is not liable to compensate the applicant for any consequential damage/loss.
- ii. The Board reserves the right to reject the candidature of any ineligible candidate at any stage of recruitment.
- iii. The Board reserves the right to cancel a part or entire process of examination or a part of it due to administrative reason(s) and in case of unfair means, cheating or other irregularities/malpractice noticed by the Board. The Board also reserves the right to cancel or setup a new examination centre and divert the candidates to appear at that examination centre if required.
- iv. The Board reserves the right to cancel any centre of exam and ask the candidates of that centre to appear at another centre. The Board also reserves the right to direct the candidates of any centre to some other centre to take the exam. No request for change in date, time and centre of exam will be accepted under any circumstances.
- v. The Board reserves the right to change or make amendment in the examination scheme, any time before the examination, if so required.
- vi. The candidature of the candidate to the written examination is entirely provisional and subject to the outcome of any direction/decision/order/pronouncement of any Court of Law and mere issue of Admit Card or appearance at the examination does not entitle him/her to any claim for the post.
- vii. The APSSB reserves the right to cancel or modify the advertisement or part of it at any stage. The number of vacancies is provisional and subject to change (increase or decrease).
- viii. Abbreviations used are denoted as under: - APST - Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe, PwD – Person with Disabilities, ExSM-Ex Serviceman.
- ix. The educational qualification, age, experience and other eligibility conditions against the post shall be determined as on the closing date of online submission of application.
- x. Use of Calculator, Laptop, Palmtop, other digital instrument/Mobile/Cell Phone/Pager/Electronic Watches etc is/are not allowed. In case any candidate is caught / found in possession of any gadget/instrument, he/she would be debarred from the examination and legal proceedings shall also be initiated against the candidate.
- xi. Candidates are advised not to bring any of the above gadgets in the exam centre as no arrangements for keeping/security of these items would be available at the centre.
