- Blind candidates & Candidates with locomotors disabilities (Both arms affected) & Cerebral Palsy where (Dominant writing) extremity is effected to the extension of slowing the performance of function (Minimum 40%) impairment.
- 2. In case of other categories of person with bench mark disabilities (minimum 40% impairment), those who have already submitted certificate to the effect that person concern has physical limitation to write from Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution (a Specialist of the relevant stream/disabilities) in the prescribed proforma.
- 3. The total compensatory time in each session i.e. morning & afternoon session will be 60 minutes with 1(one) hour interval i.e, 9. am to 1.pm in Morning session and 2 pm to 6 pm in Evening session.
