SCHEME OF EXAMINATION/SYLLABUS FOR MEDICAL OFFICER (ALLOPATHY)

(1) The examination will comprise of:

(a) Written examination: The candidates will take the examination in the following two papers each of two hours duration each carrying a maximum of 200 marks. The questions in both the papers will be so designed as to give the following weightage to different subjects.

Paper-I(Code No.): 200 Marks	Weightage
(i) General Medicine including Cardiology, Neurology, Dermatology and Psychiatry	60% (120 Marks)
(ii) Surgery including E.N.T.Opthalmology Traumatology and Orthopaedics	40%(80 Marks)
Paper-II (Code No.2): 200 Marks	
(i) Paediatrics	20 % (40 Marks)
(ii) Gynecology and Obsterics	40%(80 Marks)
(iii) Preventive, Social and Community Medicine	40%(80 Marks)
(b) VIVA-VOCE: 50(12.5 Marks)	
(i) Personality test and general aptitude	10%(10 Marks)
(ii) Canaral Medical Subjects for M.O.(Allonathy)	40%(40 Marks)

- (II) The examination in both the papers will be completely of objective (Multiple choice answere) type. The question papers (Test Booklets) will be set in English only.
- (IV) Candidates are not permitted to use calculators for answering objective type paper (Test Booklets). They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the examination Hall.
- (V) Selection on the basis of maximum marks in written and Viva -Voce.
- (VI) No negative marking/minimum qualifying Marks.
