

## ANNEXAURE - C

## SCHEME OF EXAMINATION/SYLLABUS FOR DENTAL SURGEONS

(I) The examination will comprise of:

(a) **Written examination:** - The candidate will take the examination in the following two papers each of two hours duration each carrying a maximum of 200 marks. The questions in both the papers will be so designed as to give the following weightage to different subjects.

**Paper - I (Code No. I): 200 Marks**

	Weightage
(i) Public Health Dentistry	20% (40 Marks)
(ii) Periodontology	30% (60 Marks)
(iii) Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedic	30% (60 Marks)
(iv) Oral Medicine and Radiology	20% (40 Marks)

**Paper - II (Code. No. II): 200 Marks**

	Weightage
(i) Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery	30% (60 Marks)
(ii) Conservative and Endodontics	30% (60 Marks)
(iii) Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge	30% (60 Marks)
(iv) Paediatric and Preventive Dentistry	10% (20 Marks)

(b) **VIVA - VOCE: 50 (12.5) Marks**

(i) Personality test and general aptitude	10% (10 Marks)
(ii) General Dental Science	40% (40 Marks)

(II) The examination in both the papers will be completely of objective (Multiple choice answers) type. The question papers (Test Booklets) will be set in English only.

(IV) Candidates are not permitted to use calculators for answering objective type papers (Test Booklets). They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the examination hall.

(V) Selection on the basis of maximum marks in written and viva - voce.

(VI) No negative marking/minimum qualifying marks.
