


IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS – APPSCCE – 2020

All candidates are advised to carefully peruse the Instructions stated in their Admit Cards. The following important Instructions are reiterated for the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination (APPSCCE) - 2020 (Prelims) to be held on 01-11-2020.

1. Candidates must reach their respective Examination centres well before time.
2. Candidates must carry with them their Admit Cards along with their Photo Identity Card as mentioned in their Admit Cards.
3. Entry into the Examination Centre will be closed 10 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination i.e. 8.50 AM for forenoon session and 12-50 PM for afternoon session.
4. Candidates are not permitted to leave the examination halls till the scheduled end of the Examination time i.e. 11 AM for the forenoon session and 3 PM for the afternoon session.
5. Candidates are to tear off and take away with them, the candidates' copy of the OMR Answer Sheet while leaving the Examination Hall.
6. Candidates will not be allowed entry into the Examination Centres if they are not wearing a face mask/face shield.
7. Candidates are allowed to bring their own Hand Sanitizer in transparent bottle. Beside above, Candidate have to follow COVID 19 norm of social distancing during entry / exit and inside the Examination Halls/Rooms.
8. Mobile phones, Wrist Watches and any other electronics devices are strictly barred inside the examination hall.
