NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the Department of Administrative Reforms Notification vide no. AR-27012/2/2022-SECT-1-AR dated 14th August, 2023, Arunachal Pradesh Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018 and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission hereby relax the **Minimum Qualifying Marks** for the written examination (mains) of **Arunachal Engineering Service Examination-2025.**

The minimum qualifying marks for each subject shall be as stated hereunder:

a) In order to qualify the candidate should score an aggregate of 33% of the total marks in the following 03 (three) papers of Written Examination (Mains):

SI. No.	Subject/Paper	Marks
1.	General Paper: General English, General Studies & Aptitude Test (Objective)	150
2.	Technical Paper-I (Descriptive)	150
3.	Technical Paper-II* (Descriptive)	150
Total		450

That is, a candidate has to score an aggregate of 148.50 marks out of 450 marks, subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 20% in each of the Subjects (30 marks out of the 150 marks).

- **b)** In order to qualify a PwBD category candidate should score an aggregate of 20% of the total marks in the 03 (three) papers of Written Examination (Mains), that is, aggregate of 90 marks out of 450 marks, subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 10% in each of the Subjects (15 marks out of the 150 marks).
- II. The other terms and conditions specified in the Advertisement vide no. APPSC/1/2025 dated 9th May,2025 and subsequent notifications shall remain the same.
