Sir,

I am directed to refer Commission's letter vide No.PSC-R/14/05 dated 28-9-2006 on the subject cited above and to clarify the doubts as under:-

1. Whether Mishing can be considered as APST?
Clarification: - No.
2. Whether contract employees are entitled to concession of age relaxation at par with regular Government employee?

Clarification: - the Contractual employee can not be considered as regular employee because the term "contract" clearly indicates that the appointment is for certain specified period and such appointment automatically terminates on expiry of the specified date/time. Hence, Contractual employee will not be entitled to concession of age relaxation as provided to regular Government employee.

Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter on
the ~~subject~~ above subject, and to say that a
candidate belonging to SC/ST applying directly is
entitled to relaxation upto a maximum of 5 (five)
years of age under rule 5(2)(1), while a government
servant is entitled to age relaxation upto a maximum
of five years under Rule 5(2)(vi).

However, if one is in the category of
SC/ST and is also in government service under the
government of Arunachal Pradesh, he is entitled to
both the relaxations. Action may be taken accordingly.

No. AR-28/13.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is hereby pleased to make the following **rules to regulate the upper age-limit for direct recruitment to the Arunachal Civil Services and Civil Posts** under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement :** (1) These rules may be called the Arunachal Civil Services and Civil Posts (Upper Age-Limit for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force on their date of publication in the official Gazette of Arunachal Pradesh.

2. **Application :** (1) These rules shall apply to Arunachal Civil Services and Civil Posts under the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

(2) These rules shall not apply to direct recruitment to any State Civil Services or Civil Posts under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh for which actions for recruitment is initiated through open advertisement or otherwise before the date of publication of this rule.

(3) These rules shall not apply also to recruitment to executive post(s) in uniform services namely, Arunachal Pradesh Civil Police, Arunachal Armed Police Battalion, India Reserve Battalion, Wireless and Telecom, Fire Service, Jail Service, Range Forest Officer, Forester, Forest Guard, Special Tiger Force/Inspector Tax and Excise, Assistant Inspector Tax and Excise and Constable Tax and Excise where physical training is mandatory.

3. **Age :** The age for direct recruitment by the method of direct open competitive examination to the State Civil Services and Civil Posts shall be 18 to 30 years.

4. **Amendment of Recruitment Rules :** All rules regulating the method of recruitment of person to Arunachal Civil Services and Civil Posts under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh governing Open Competitive Examination shall stand amended to the extent provided for in Rule 3.

5. **Interpretation :** If any question arises as to the interpretation of these rules, the same shall be decided by the State Government.

6. **Categories of persons and extent of concessions :** Certain age concessions have in the past been sanctioned to few specified categories of person for the purpose of appointment to Civil Services/Civil Posts under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. These concessions are Still in force until further orders. Details of the categories of person and age concession admissible to them are as given below :—

Category of Persons to whom age coession is admissible	Category of posts to which the age concession is admissible	Extent of age concession
1	2	3
(i) Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe (APST)	All posts filled by direct recruitment	5 (five) years
(ii) Ex-servicemen and demobilized personnel of Armed Forces	All posts filled by direct recruitment	Service rendered in Army, Navy and Air Force plus 3 (three) years.

(ii) Educationally qualified erstwhile Group "D" (now Multi Tasking Staff) Employees.	For appointment to the post of LDCs against 10% reserved quota.	Up to 45 years of age (for APST up to 50 years).
(iv) Departmental candidates with 3 years continuous service.	For appointment to Group 'C' by direct recruitment which are in the same line or allied cadres.	Up to 40 years of age (for APST up to 45 years).
(v) Casual laborers/Contingency for absorption in regular establishment in erstwhile Group 'D' post (now multi tasking staff).	For lowest rung Group 'C' posts/Multi Tasking Staff (erstwhile Group 'D' post)	Period spent as casual laborer. Broken period of service rendered as a casual laborer may also be taken into account for the purpose of age relaxation for appointment in regular establishment, provided that one stretch of service is for more than six months.
(vi) Blind, Deaf-mute and orthopedically handicapped persons.	All civil posts filled through open competitive examination.	Ten years (15 years for APST).
(vii) Meritorious Sports person.	All Groups of Civil posts.	Up to 5 years (10 years for APST candidates).
(viii) Widows, divorced women and women judicially separated from their husbands and who are not re-married.	For Group 'C' posts filled through open competitive examination.	Up to the age of 35 years (Up to 40 years for APST).
