I am directed to refer Commission's letter vide No. PSC-R/14/05 dated 28-9-2006 on the subject cited above and to clarify the doubts as under:-

1. Whether Mishing can be considered as APST?  
**Clarification:** - No.
2. Whether contract employees are entitled to concession of age relaxation at par with regular Government employee?

**Clarification:** - the Contractual employee can not be considered as regular employee because the term "contract" clearly indicates that the appointment is for certain specified period and such appointment automatically terminates on expiry of the specified date/time. Hence, Contractual employee will not be entitled to concession of age relaxation as provided to regular Government employee.

under APCS (Competative Examination)  
Regulation- 1992.

Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter on the subject above subject, and to say that a candidate belonging to SC/ST applying directly is entitled to relaxation upto a maximum of 5 (five) years of age under rule 5(2)(1), while a government servant is entitled to age relaxation upto a maximum of five years under Rule 5(2)(vi).

However, if one is in the category of SC/ST and is also in government service under the government of Arunachal Pradesh, he is entitled to both the relaxations. Action may be taken accordingly.
