## **NOTIFICATION**

In pursuance of the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive Examination Rule, 2019, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Department of Administrative Reforms Notification vide no. AR-27012/2/2022-SECT-1-AR dated 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2023, Arunachal Pradesh Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2018 and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission hereby relax the Minimum Qualifying Marks for the written examination of Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Combined Competitive (Main) Examination-2024.

The minimum qualifying marks for each subject shall be as stated hereunder:

1. English (Compulsory): 33% of the total marks (300 marks) for candidates of all categories.

The English (Compulsory) paper will be of qualifying nature and candidates across all categories must score 33% of the total marks (300 marks) in this paper. The marks obtained in this paper shall not be counted for merit, however, the rest of the subject papers shall be evaluated only if the candidate qualifies in this paper.

- **2. Merit Subjects** (Essay, General Studies-I, General Studies-II, General Studies-III, General Studies-IV, Optional subject-I and Optional Subject-II):
  - a) In order to qualify the candidate should score an aggregate of 33% of the total marks of 07 papers (that is, aggregate of 577.50 marks out of 1750 marks) subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 20% in each of 07 Merit Subjects.
  - **b)** In order to qualify a PwBD category candidate should score an aggregate of 20% of the total marks of 07 papers (that is, aggregate of 350 marks out of 1750 marks) subject to the condition that the candidate should score at least 10% in each of 07 Merit Subjects.

3. The other terms and conditions specified in the Advertisement vide no. PSC-R(A)/12/2024 dated 10.10.2024 and subsequent notifications shall remain the same.
